About Camp Doucet

Camp Doucet is located on 25 acres of woodland in the southern section of Nashua. It is a summer day camp for boys and girls, ages 8 to 12, conducted by the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua.

Trip Weeks

The Camp Doucet program offers 1 trip week for its members. It is usually Week 1. Members will meet at the Boys & Girls Club to start their day. After camper check-in, campers will board a bus to enjoy their adventure of the day. Campers will enjoy state parks, water parks, amusement parks, hiking, and more! This week will have a series of activities, which will be given to parents prior to the start of trip week.

Special Note

Currently, camp weeks are listed on the back of this brochure. These weeks are subject to camp availability and school calendar changes. We will continue to update the programming as it becomes available.

Please note that Camp Doucet will be closed on Monday, July 5, 2010.

The price for week 2 is reduced to \$65 for the week, due to the holiday.

Membership

All campers must be registered as a current member of the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua. If your son or daughter is not currently a member, or will be expiring during the summer, a completed membership application and a \$25 membership fee will be required.

Age Restrictions

Camp Doucet registration is open to boys and girls, ages 8 to 12. Special age exceptions may be granted, depending on the authorization of the Camp Director.

What to bring to camp

Each day, campers should bring a lunch that does not require refrigeration, a swimsuit, sunscreen and a towel. Campers are asked to have both a lunchbox and a backpack for carrying all personal items. **All belonging and clothing should be marked for identification purposes.** Campers should not bring any electronic games, radios, cell phones, or other items of value.

Camp Attire

All campers are asked to wear closed toed shoes for each day at camp. Comfortable play clothes are recommended, although no mid-riff shirts please. Camp shirts are required to be worn on all excursions and field trip days. Camp Doucet will provide 1 shirt for each camper. Additional camp shirts are available at a cost of \$8 each.

Extended hours

Supervision from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm inside the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua is available for campers at a cost of \$15 per week. Parents are expected to pay the week prior to their child attending this service. Campers participating in this service will be bussed to and from camp each day if needed.

Weekly Fees

The weekly fee for Camp Doucet is \$80. Each week of camp may be reserved with a deposit of \$20 per week with a balance of \$60 per week to be paid no later than the Monday prior to the reserved week. If the balance is not received by that Monday, the reserved week and full deposit will be forfeited. A \$20 fee will again be charged to reregister provided space is available.

The weekly camp fee covers all costs including transportation, supervision, program and activity materials. You may prepay in full or with a deposit for as many weeks as you wish. Early registration is encouraged as spaces may fill quickly. A waiting list will be



Multiple Family Members

The cost per camper per session is \$80 per week per camper. If there are 2 members of the same family, living in the same household, the cost is \$70 per week per camper. If there are 3 or more members of the same family, living in the same household, the cost is \$60 per week per camper.

Refund & Cancellation Policy

All refunds, credits and transfers must be made at least 1 week prior to the start of the camp session. If a camper cancels 21 days prior to camp, a full refund may be given. If canceling 14 days or more prior to camp, a \$15 administrative fee will be assessed per camper. If canceling less than 7 days prior to the start of the camp week, no refund will be given. No refunds or credits will be given after the camp week has started. **Please be advised that there will be no refund for missed days.**

Important Payment Information

Personal check, cash and money order will be accepted for camp payments. Initial registration must be done in person or mailed to the Boys & Girls Club. A \$20.00 fee will be assessed on all returned checks. Parents should keep receipts on file, as Camp Doucet does not prepare end-of-the year statements of fees paid. The Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua's federal ID number is 23-7058376.

Financial Assistance
