Challenge met. Our future is more secure.



Last fall, the Club received a \$100,000 challenge legacy grant from **Dick Stahl** with provisions that the we raise an additional \$150,000 to establish an endowment for the continuing support of the new Teen Center's programs. This donation was in addition to the initial \$250,000 seed money that the Club received from **Dick and Ellen Stahl** for the Teen Center and Clubhouse Improvement project. Ten donors - seven of whom already belonged to the **Heritage Club** and three

new members - met the challenge and the total reached \$293,000.

These donors named the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Nashua as beneficiary through IRA accounts, life insurance policies, annuities, 401k's, wills, trusts, and outright donations.

As a result of this increased endowment, the Foundation will be able to support the Club's efforts with an annual distribution of approximately \$30,000 each year.

The Heritage Club is made up of supporters from all over the country who have included a local club in a planned gift.

The local endowment is managed by the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Nashua Charitable Foundation whose Trustees include **Thomas Monahan (Chair), Norm Bouthilette, David Brassard, James Conway, Sal Mag-**

nano, Thomas J. McCartney, Robert Moheban, Martha O'Neill, Fred Roedel, Terry Romano and Sam Tamposi, Jr.

The Clubhouse Improvement Project which includes the recently completed Teen Center will enable the Boys and Girls Club to continue to provide core programs and services for over 4,200 members. The remainder of the project will be finished by summer. The Club is seeking additional support in order to attain its \$4 million goal and all donations and pledges will be matched by the Kresge Foundation.

Charitable Gift Annuities: Triple Play

Recent average CD yields in *USA Today* were 2.26% for a 5-year CD. If you are 60 or older, you can "beat" low CD rates; receive fixed payments for life; and make a tax favored donation to the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua. **Even better**, a portion of your charitable gift will be matched by the **Kresge Foundation**. Kresge will donate \$500,000 for the Teen Center & Clubhouse Improvement project if we can add \$500,000 to the \$3 million we've already raised.

This gift arrangement is a charitable gift annuity. In exchange for a gift of

\$10,000 or more, the donor will receive fixed payments for one life or two lives. At the end of life, the Boys & Girls Club will receive the remainder of the gift, which Kresge will match based on actuarial predictions of that future gift

Examples of annuity annual rates are at right. The tax deductibility of a portion of the gift raises the effective rates, depending on your tax bracket.
