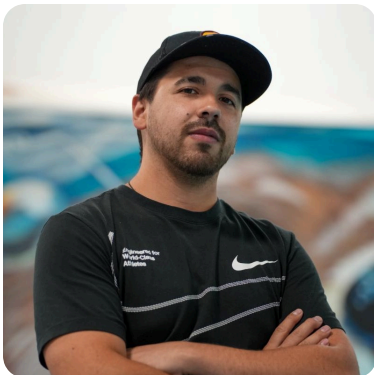

POSITIVE ACTION AT THE CLUB: SAFETY & WELLNESS

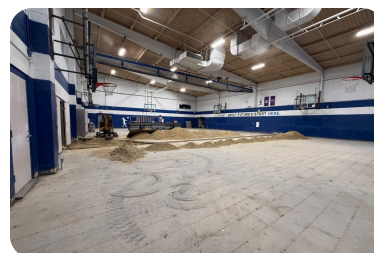
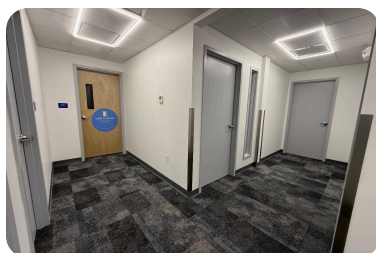

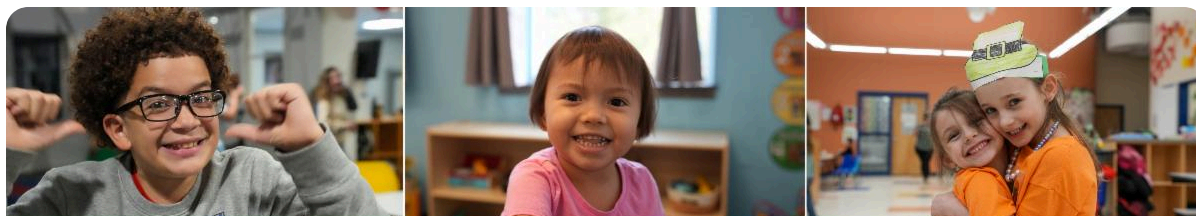
